1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject's daughter, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to change the service member's name and date of birth listed on the NAVPERS 553.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 13 November 2017 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Subject was born on [REDACTED] and named [REDACTED] as evidenced by his birth certificate.

c. Subject entered active duty in the United States Navy on 28 July 1942 and served until his Honorable discharge on 18 May 1945.
