1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's Soft Expiration of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) is 22 July 2022.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 7 October 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 4 January 2018, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0048) with an obligated service to July 2021, while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of April 2018. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of July 2018.

c. On 23 February 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years with an end of active obligated service (EAOS) of 22 February 2021.

d. On 7 March 2018, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 5 months with an SEAOS of 22 July 2021 in order to incur sufficient obligated service to execute BUPERS order: 0048.

e. On 8 February 2021, Petitioner signed a Command Career Request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 12 month agreement to extend enlistment in order to match EAOS with projected rotation date (PRD), and was approved by cognizant authority on 10 February 2020.

f. On 11 February 2021, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 16 months with an SEAOS of 22 November 2022 in order to match EAOS with PRD

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g. On 26 February 2021, Commanding Officer, [REDACTED] notified Commander, Navy Personnel Command that the extension requested was requested to match member's EAOS to member's PRD. Due to administrative error, the term was erroneously entered as 16 months. This action took member past his PRD of 22 July 2022.

h. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner requested to execute an agreement to extend enlistment to have his EAOS match his PRD. Petitioner erroneously executed a 16-month vice 12-month agreement to extend enlistment on 11 February 2021 to have his EAOS match PRD of July 2022.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 11 February 2021 was for a term of 12 months vice 16 months.

Note: This will establish an EAOS of 22 July 2022.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
