¹ Reference (b), eligible Chief Warrant Officer (CWO) selectees may apply for a bonus level of \$45,000 for accepting a commission and serving on active duty in designators 7151 and 7171 for a 4-year bonus obligated service period. The initial commission service obligation for CWO is 6 years and will run concurrent with the bonus obligation, the NSW Plan and Policy Branch (OPNAV N137) is designated as the NSWAB Program Manager. Applicants should submit applications for this bonus to the program manager for approval, payment processing and tracking prior to the commissioning date. The eligibility criteria stated in the Navy Administrative message can change at any time by the program manager if a bonus reduction is warranted based on the needs of the NSW community.

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- d. On 30 April 2023, Petitioner discharged with 18 years, 5 months, and 28 days of active duty service to accept warrant in same branch of service.
- e. On 1 May 2023, Petitioner accepted appointment to CWO2/7151, entered active duty and assigned to for duty through 1 June 2023.
- f. Petitioner was assigned to assigned as a student on temporary duty from 3 June 2023 through 30 June 2023.
 - g. On 3 July 2023, Petitioner reported to for duty.
- h. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that due to administrative oversight, Petitioner received improper counseling from the service level that resulted in his decision not to elect NSWAB. Therefore, the Board agreed that under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner requested NSWAB prior to commissioning and the request was approved by cognizant authority effective 1 May 2023. Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to NSWAB in the amount of \$45,000. Contact Deputy Branch Head, NSW Program Manager (OPNAV N137) concerning payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
