1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 25 May 2022 for 4 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB), and was eligible to transfer his education benefits.

2. The Board, consisting of **Construction**, **Construction**, and **Construction** reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 6 February 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 17 May 2016, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 16 May 2020 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 16 May 2022; "Training in the Nuclear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500,1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 Subj: REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORD ICO XXX-XX-

months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

b. On 3 September 2017, Petitioner got married.

c. On 10 August 2018, Petitioner transferred from **10**, and arrived to on 27 August 2018 for duty.

d. In September 2018, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N26O.

e. On 25 March 2019, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 24 March 2025 and received a Zone A SRB.

f. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

g. In August 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC N26S.

h. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 7.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N26O/S rate/NEC was listed.

i. In October 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC 825A.

j. On 25 October 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order:) with required obligated service to June 2025, while stationed in **Service**, **Service**,

k. On 8 February 2022, Petitioner transferred from **March 2022**, and arrived to **on 7 March 2022** for temporary duty.

l. On 11 February 2022, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Service Record (ESR) shows a 3-month agreement to extend enlistment with an SEAOS of 24 June 2025.

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m. In accordance with reference (d), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 002/FY22), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N26O/S rate/NEC was listed.

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n. On 17 May 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B.

p. On petitioner's child was born.

q. In October 2023, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A.

r. On 29 January 2024, Petitioner's Benefits for Education Administrative Service Tool listed no dependents.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 25 October 2021, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: with required obligated service to June 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 11 February 2022, NSIPS/ESR shows a 3-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. On 17 May 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 25 May 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB. Furthermore, Petitioner would have been eligible to transfer his education benefits to his dependents.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 3-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 25 March 2025 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 11 February 2022 agreeing to extend enlistment for 3 months for OBLISERV to June 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 24 May 2022 and reenlisted on 25 May 2022 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N26S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 24 March 2025 will be deducted from SRB computation. Additionally, Navy Personnel Command is authorized to align transfer of education benefits with the 25 May 2022

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reenlistment. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, <u>.</u> concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
