- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to the Loan Repayment Program (LRP).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, and ______ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 May 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:
- a. On 20 January 2023, Petitioner enlisted in the Navy for a term of 8-years of which 4-years is considered an active duty obligation. NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees Annex "A" listed Advanced Electronics Field-Advanced Electronics Computer Field (AEF/AECF 6YO) Program that required a voluntary extension for 24-months; Enlistment Bonus for College Credit (EBCC) \$8,000 Bonus; and Enlistment Bonus for Shipping (EBSHP) \$25,000 Bonus. Active Duty Service Date (ADSD): 23 March 2023.
 - b. On 13 February 2023, Petitioner's ADSD changed to 6 April 2023.
- c. On 21 February 2023, Petitioner and recruiter signed/completed four DD Form 2475, LRP Annual Applications totaling \$15,000 in unpaid principal.

d.	On 6 April 2023, Petitioner entered active duty.
e.	On 15 June 2023, Petitioner completed Recruit Basic Military Training, detached and reported to as a student on duty under instruction.
f.	On 7 August 2023, Petitioner issued Secret clearance.
_	On 15 August 2023, Department of Education—, Loan Servicing Specialist signed oner's four DD Form 2475, LRP Annual Applications.
h. 2024.	On 2 February 2024, Petitioner detached and reported to as a student on duty under instruction on 5 February

- i. On 25 March 2024, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account reflects Petitioner has been paid enlistment bonuses totaling \$33,000.
- j. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner med the basic eligibility criteria for LRP in accordance with reference (b). However, because LRP was not annotated on the Petitioner's Annex "A," he was deemed ineligible to receive the incentive. Although proper administrative requirements were not completed, the Board felt that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantee – Annex "A" to DD Form 4 dated 20 January 2023 is amended to reflect Option 4: "Loan Repayment Program – Up to \$65,000."

Petitioner completed and submitted all required LRP documents to cognizant authorities in a timely manner. Note: To complete the process, Petitioner must contact the Navy Recruiting Command LRP Program Manager at cnrc_lrp-eb@navy.mil with contact information to include

¹ Reference (b), any future Sailor initially classified or reclassified on or after 2 January 2023 in any rating/programs that shipped October through September of any fiscal year were eligible for LRP up to \$65,000. Future Sailors must have LRP listed as a guarantee in their current Annex to DD Form 4, Enlistment/Reenlistment Document in order to maintain eligibility.
