1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 13 January 2023 for 3 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of **Example**, **Example**, and **Example**, and **Example** reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 March 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 12 January 2016, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 11 January 2020 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 11 January 2022; "Training in the Nuclear Field Program, and advancement to E-4, per MILPERSMAN 1160-040, and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040. In particular, I understand that, when I accept advancement to E-4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled, whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

b. On 27 February 2018, Petitioner transferred from **19**, and arrived to on 29 March 2018 for duty.

c. On 7 December 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 6 December 2024 and received a Zone A SRB.

d. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

e. In September 2020, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N54Z, N14S, and 766A.

f. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 7.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S rate/NEC was listed.

g. On 18 November 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order:
) with required obligated service to May 2025, while stationed in ______,

activity was with an effective date of departure of April 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was with a projected Rotation Date of May 2025. Obligated service to May 2025 is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

h. In December 2021, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N33Z.

i. On 12 January 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B.

j. On 20 April 2022, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 5 months with an SEAOS of 6 May 2025 in order to incur sufficient service to execute BUPERS order.

k. On 22 April 2022, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner's Submarine Pay stopped.

m. In accordance with reference (d) FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 001/FY23), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S rate/NEC was listed.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosures (2) and (3), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 18 November 2021, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: with required obligated service to May 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 12 January 2022, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 20 April 2022, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 5 months to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 13 January 2023, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 5-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 20 April 2022 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 20 April 2022 agreeing to extend enlistment for 5 months for OBLISERV to May 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 12 January 2023 and reenlisted on 13 January 2023 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 6 December 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, . concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
