1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's reenlistment contract of 5 April 2023 was designated as a Selective Training and Reenlistment (STAR) and that he was advanced to E-5 upon reenlistment.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 11 April 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 26 March 2020, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 25 March 2024 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 25 March 2026.

b. In June 2020, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N91T.

c. On 16 October 2020, Petitioner was advance do MMN3/E-4.

d. On 15 March 2022, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0742) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of April

2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 25 May 2022 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of November 2026.

e. In April 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC N150.

f. On 17 May 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 21 June 2022 for duty.

g. In accordance with reference (b) (13 February 2023), the STAR Program offers career designation to first term enlisted Sailors who reenlist and thereby become eligible for the following career incentives: a. Guaranteed assignment to an appropriate "C" school. b. Possible advancement from petty officer third class (PO3) to petty officer second class (PO2) upon completion of a Class "C" School or a "C" School package, which is listed in NAVEDTRA 10500 and the Career Schools Listing (CSL). Most updated CSL will be located on the MyNavy HR Web page. c. Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB), if eligible (not guaranteed).

h. In accordance with reference (c) (20 July 2023), rating-NEC MMN/N150 (Nuclear Propulsion Plant Operator - Mechanical) with an OBLISERV of 6 years was listed with the following notes: MPM 1160-100 outlines the OBLISERV requirements for STAR program reenlistment.

i. On 29 September 2023, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 28 September 2029 and received a Zone A SRB.

j. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was awarded NEC N150 in April 2022 which is listed on reference (c) as being eligible for the STAR Program. Petitioner reenlisted on 29 September 2023 for 6 years; if the Command Career Counselor had submitted a STAR request to BUPERS-328 it would have been approved, and Petitioner would have advanced to E-5 upon his reenlistment.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner executed an immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) on 29 September 2023 for a term of 6 years and listed "Career designated under MILPERSMAN 1160-100."

Petitioner was advanced to MMN2/E-5 on 29 September 2023.
