

A review of your record reflects your PEBD is 16 February 2011, you completed BRS Opt-in training (J3OP-US1332) on 1 November 2017, and you enrolled in BRS on 9 January 2018. Your CP election window opened on 16 August 2022 and the Service provided you CP eligibility notifications to █, with the last email being sent on 16 January 2023. Your last day to elect CP was on 15 February 2023. The Board considered █
█ memorandum dated 29 July 2024, and determined you had the opportunity to elect CP before and after the ship's deployment; 16 August 2022 to 26 October 2022 and 27 January 2023 to 15 February 2023. Therefore in this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the advisory opinion, and determined a change to your record is not warranted.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
