1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 24 January 2022 for 3 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 March 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 23 July 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 22 July 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 22 July 2020; "Training in the Nuclear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500, 1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be canceled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this

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agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training.”

b. On 14 September 2016, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 11 October 2016 for duty.

c. On 23 January 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 22 January 2023 and received a Zone A SRB.

d. In June 2018, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) 734B. In July 2019, Petitioner was awarded NEC N25S.

e. On 6 November 2019, Petitioner got married.

f. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB award levels and reenlistment policy for Active Duty and Full Time Support, updates to the pay for performance pilot (a Sailor 2025 initiative) and changes to how future SRB award levels will be announced. SRB award levels and reenlistment policy listed in this NAVADMIN superseded those contained in NAVADMIN 129/19. Sailors must have reenlisted within 270-days of their EAOS, except in the following cases: Nuclear-trained Sailors. Sailors who must obligate service (OBLISERV) to execute a permanent change of station move were allowed to reenlist early any time within 1 Calendar Year of the detachment month, but not later than the date of detachment from the last intermediate duty station. Furthermore, a Zone “B” SRB with an award level of 5.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N25O/S rate/NEC was listed.

g. On 3 March 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]) with required obligated service to February 2024, while stationed in [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of September 2020. Petitioner’s intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 19 October 2020. Petitioner’s ultimate activity was MTS 701, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 6 February 2021 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of February 2024. Obligated service to February 2024 is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

h. On 6 April 2020, Petitioner signed an agreement for 13 months with an SEAOS of 22 February 2024 in order to incur sufficient obligated service to execute BUPERS order [REDACTED].

i. In accordance with reference (c), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

j. On 23 July 2020, Petitioner entered zone B.

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- k. On 20 September 2020, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 20 October 2020 for temporary duty.
- l. In February 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A.
- m. On 6 February 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 6 February 2021 for duty.
- n. In accordance with reference (d), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone “B” SRB with an award level of 7.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N250/S rate/NEC was listed.
- o. In January 2023, Petitioner was awarded NEC N33Z.
- p. On 29 September 2023, Petitioner was issued official separation orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]) while stationed in [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of January 2024. Petitioner’s place elected for travel: [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an actual date of separation of 22 February 2024.
- q. On 7 December 2023, Petitioner was issued official cancellation to separation orders (2723).
- r. On 23 February 2024, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Service Record (ESR) shows a 11-month agreement to extend enlistment with an SEAOS of 22 January 2025.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 3 March 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: [REDACTED] with required obligated service to February 2024. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (b), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 6 April 2020, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 13 months to meet the OBLISERV. On 23 July 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 24 January 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner’s naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner’s 13-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 6 April 2020 is null and void.

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Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 6 April 2020 agreeing to extend enlistment for 13 months for OBLISERV to February 2024.

Petitioner's 11-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 23 February 2024 is null and void.

Petitioner was discharged 23 January 2022 and reenlisted on 24 January 2022 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "7.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N25O rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 22 January 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will not take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will not be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). [REDACTED] at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, [REDACTED] concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
