- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 14 October 2021 for 4 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, and _____ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 26 March 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 13 October 2015, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 12 October 2019 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 12 October 2021; "Training in the Nuclear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1300-500, 1300-502, and 1300-502 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active duty service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510 030. In particular, I understand that when I accept

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advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."
b. On 8 April 2017, Petitioner got married.
c. On 20 July 2017, Petitioner transferred from on 20 August 2017 for duty.
d. On 26 January 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 25 January 2024 and received a Zone A SRB.
e. On 16 April 2018, Petitioner's dependent child was born.
f. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
g. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 003/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15O/S rate/NEC was listed.
h. In April 2021, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N15S.
i. On 26 April 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 1161) with required obligated service to September 2024, while stationed in with an effective date of departure of August 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 15 September 2021 with a projected rotation date (PRD) of September 2024. Obligated service to September 2024 is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.
j. In July 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC N33Z.
k. In accordance with reference (d), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15O/S rate/NEC was listed.
1. On 16 August 2021, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 1161) with required obligated service to January 2025, while stationed in with an effective date of departure of December 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 19 January 2022 with a PRD of January 2025. Obligated service to January

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2025 is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

- m. On 16 September 2021, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 12 months with a SEAOS of 25 January 2025 in order to incur sufficient obligated service to execute BUPERS order 1161.
 - n. On 13 October 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B.
- o. On 17 December 2021, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner's Submarine Pay stopped.
- p. On 17 December 2021, Petitioner transferred from on 19 January 2022 for duty.
- q. On 25 March 2024, Petitioner's Benefits for Education Administrative Service Tool listed no dependents.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosures (2) and (3), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 16 August 2021, Petitioner was issued official modification to BUPERS order: 1161 with required obligated service to January 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (d), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 16 September 2021, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 12 months to meet the OBLISERV. On 13 October 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 14 October 2021, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB. Furthermore, Petitioner would have been eligible to transfer his education benefits to his dependents, if he so chooses.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 12-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 16 September 2021 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 16 September 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 12 months for OBLISERV to January 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 13 October 2021 and reenlisted on 14 October 2021 for a term of 4 years.

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Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15S, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 25 January 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Additionally, Navy Personnel Command is authorized to align transfer of education benefits with the 14 October 2021 reenlistment, upon Petitioner's request. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA).

at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
