1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show that Petitioner reenlisted on 15 December 2023 vice 6 December 2023 and was entitled to a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 August 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to the Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegation of error or injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 11 December 2013, Petitioner entered active duty.

b. In September 2017, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) 825A. In June 2018, Petitioner was awarded NEC 746A. In March 2020, Petitioner was awarded NEC 8CFL.

c. On 10 May 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: ██████████) with required obligated service to August 2024, while stationed in ██████████ with an effective date of departure of July 2021. Petitioner's ultimate

activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 August 2021 with a projected rotation date (PRD) of August 2024.

d. On 21 May 2021, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years with an end of active obligated service (EAOS) of 20 May 2024 and received a Zone B SRB.

e. On 24 May 2021, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 3 months with a Soft EAOS of 20 August 2024 in order to incur sufficient obligated service to execute BUPERS order 1301.

f. On 22 July 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 12 November 2021 for temporary duty.

g. On 16 October 2023, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 4-year reenlistment effective 6 December 2023 and SRB. Petitioner's request was approved 26 October 2023 by cognizant authority.

h. On 10 November 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 12 November 2021 for duty.

i. On 20 November 2023, COMNAVPERSCOM notified [REDACTED] that Petitioner's SRB with an award level of 3.0 Zone B request was granted based on a 4-year reenlistment effective 6 December 2023.

j. In May 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC 735A. In May 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC H00M.

k. On 6 December 2023, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 5 December 2027.

l. On 11 December 2023, Petitioner entered Zone C.

m. On 16 April 2024, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]) with required obligated service to September 2027, while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of August 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 September 2024 with a PRD of September 2027.

n. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an error warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years on 6 December

2023 and was erroneously approved for a Zone B SRB. Per reference (b),<sup>1</sup> a member may receive only one SRB per Zone during their career. Petitioner received a Zone B SRB for his reenlistment of 21 May 2021. Petitioner crossed into Zone C on 11 December 2023. Petitioner should have been advised to reenlist after entering Zone C. On 15 December 2023, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone C SRB.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on "14/15 December 2023" vice "5/6 December 2023" for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone "C" SRB with an award level of 2.5 (\$60,000 dollar award ceiling) for the IT/735A rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 20 May 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation.

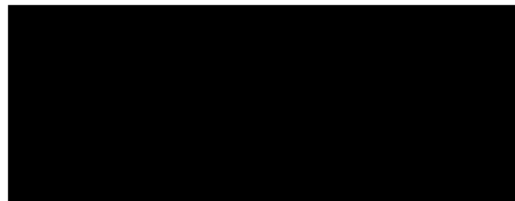
Note: The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will not take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will not be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). The Navy will secure funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.

<sup>1</sup> If the current SRB NAVADMIN publishes the use of zones, the guidance regarding zones in table 1-1 must be adhered to. A member may receive only one SRB per zone during a career. When reenlisting for SRB, the reenlistment must take the member's new EAOS into the next SRB zone.
