Dear

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 8 August 2024. The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. You note on your application that you discovered the error/injustice on 31 January 1995. You requested the Board amend your record to reflect your promotion to HM1 no later than April 1987, promotion to HMC on 16 January 1993, and financial compensation. The Board determined your counsel implies your mental health concerns were the justification for your delay. The Board however, determined you provided insufficient reason to find it in the interest of justice to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. In reaching this conclusion, the Board determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since the withdrawal of your promotion recommendation.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
