existin	fore applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under g law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the f record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
a. (On 23 November 2020, Petitioner transferred from on 19 January 2021 for duty.
	On 15 May 2023, Petitioner signed a Dependency Application (NAVPERS 1070/602) listing buse's address of

Petitioner's ultimate activity was 1st for duty with an effective date of arrival of 14 ary 2024 with a projected rotation date of February 2027. This transfer funded for member and ized dependents as reflected on service record page two and other supporting documents.
	On 3 January 2024, Commanding Officer, Medical Battalion notified Commander, Navy nel Command (PERS-407) via First Endorsement on Petitioner's letter of 21 December 2023

that, "[i]n accordance with Title 37 U.S.C. Chapter 7 (Section 403), JFTR Chapter 10, NAVADMIN 026/09, and Ser N130C, the requesting service member is authorized to receive BAH based on their previous PDS. Please remove the funding for HHG [household goods] move from the members orders and reissue those orders.

The member established a residence prior to the date the member's orders were issued, the member will be commuting daily to their new PDS, and the commuting distance is reasonable for this geographic location.

With the removal of the funding for a HHG move, the member realizes they have forfeited the authorization for the government to fund a move. The member will forfeit the right to receive BAH based on their previous PDS if the member moves their residence at their own expense. As indicated in the request, the member acknowledges that any obligated service associated with these orders must still be completed."

- e. On 12 January 2024, Petitioner transferred from on 9 February 2024 for duty.
- f. On 12 February 2024, MyNavy Career Center (MNCC) notified Petitioner that, "1306 request for BAH for close proximity move returned without action. Member is ACC (Accounting Category Codes) 400 (System generated when loss from on bound activity processed). All late requests must be sent to BCNR for review and approval."
- g. On 15 February 2024, Petitioner's BAH at the with-dependents rate for stopped effective 8 February 2024 and BAH at the with-dependents rate for started on 9 February 2024.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 3 January 2024, Petitioner's gaining command notified Navy Personnel Command (PERS-407) that they requested to remove the funding for HHG move from Petitioner's orders and reissue those orders for authorization to receive BAH based on the previous PDS. Petitioner established a residence prior to the date orders were issued, he will be commuting daily to his new PDS, and the commuting distance is reasonable for the geographic location. The Board determined that Petitioner met the requirements listed in reference (b), however Petitioner's orders were not modified prior to the execution of those orders and Petitioner began to receive BAH based on the new PDS.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's request for a close proximity move was approved by cognizant authority prior to executing orders (BUPERS order: 2493).

Petitioner's BAH at the with-dependents rate for "grant of "vice" vice "vice", started on 9 February 2024. Note: If Petitioner moves from his residence, he will no longer be authorized BAH at the old PDS.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
