Dear █,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 24 September 2024. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained in Commanding Officer, Navy Pay and Personnel Support Center (NPPSC) memorandum 1900 N1 of 1 August 2024, which was previously provided to you for comment.

On 22 April 2021, you were issued Mobilization Order Extension with an effective date of orders 19 June 2019. Furthermore, the following listed “[p]rocessing and post-deployment leave, member should expect to detach no later than 31 May 22. To remain on station beyond 31 May 22, member must submit a new VSA with an updated desired detach date no later than 180 days prior to 31 May 22 for USFF determination of mission requirement and appropriate approval authority.”

On 24 September 2021, you were issued BUPERS orders. Furthermore, Chief of Naval Personnel (PERS 462) notified Commanding Officer █, █, Official Active Duty for Operational Support Orders for LCDR █, USNR. “Per reference (a) [SEC 12301/D/Title 10 USC], you are hereby ordered to report for Active Duty for Operational Support under the authority of Title 10 USC Section 12301/D/ and IAW references (b) through (e) [OPNAVINST 1001.20 SERIES/ Assistant Secretary of Defense memo 16 June 2004/ JTR/ RTN SE-5168-6667 ADOS RTN MPN-22-60-5168-6667]. Period of duty: 01 Oct 21 to

31 Mar 22 depart place from which called (or ordered) to active duty (PLEAD) NET 01Oct21.”

On 31 March 2022, Separations Questionnaire (NPPSC 1900/1) was created with a separation date of 31 March 2022 and certified by both Medical and Commanding Officer or Designee and certified by you on 31 March 2022.

On 5 July 2022, your Reporting Senior signed a Fitness Report and Counseling Record (NAVPERS 1610/2) for the period of 1 November 2021 to 31 March 2022. Occasion for report was “Detachment of Individual.”

You were released from active duty and transferred to the Naval Reserve with an Honorable character of service and were issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 7 July 2017 to 31 March 2022 upon completion of required active service. Block 16 (Days Accrued leave paid) listed 58.5. Signed by Official Authorized To Sign on 6 July 2022.

On 7 July 2022, your Master Military Pay Account listed your base pay stopped effective 31 March 2022.

On 4 August 2022, Commanding Officer, ██████████ notified Commanding Officer, ██████████ that “[p]er references (a) [BUPERSINST 1001.39] and (b) [RESPERS M-1001.5, request entry be removed or changed to IDT Participation record (NAVRES 1570/022). Member was on ADOS orders under my command from 1 September 2022 through 30 June 2022. Request IDT Participation modification to reflect that member remained activated through 30 June 2022 and that member is authorized to reschedule drill periods for April through June.”

“Member's ADOS orders ended effective 31 March 2022, however due to administrative delays he was still attached to my Command and effectively activated until DD-214 processing was completed 30 June 2022.”

“Member is no longer on active duty and has out-processed. No further action required.”

On 18 May 2023, DFAS notified you of an indebtedness to the U.S. Government for \$6,891.43 for the following reason: “Debt is due to payments received after you entered a no pay status due to separation as of 03/31/2022. These payments are as follows: a mid-month payment of \$4,525.07 dated 04/15/2022, an end of month payment of \$4,499.92 dated 04/30/2022, a mid-month payment of \$4,500.07 dated 05/15/2022, and an end of month payment of \$4,499.92 dated 05/31/2022. If you disagree with the validity or amount of your debt, please contact the Pay Office, DMPO, or AFAFO that placed you in debt and have them provide our office with proper documentation to alter or cancel your debt.”

On 16 June 2023, you were awarded the Meritorious Service Medal for the period of September 2021 to May 2022.
