1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 29 August 2020 for 4 years, was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 25 June 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 1 May 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 30 April 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 30 April 2020; "Training in the Nuclear Field Program and advancement to E-4 per MILPERSMAN Articles 1160-040 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN Article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E-4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

b. On 17 October 2015, Petitioner got married.

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- c. In August 2016, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N16O.
- d. On 25 November 2016, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 25 November 2016 for duty.
- e. On 29 September 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 28 September 2023 and received a Zone A SRB.
- f. On 30 May 2018, Petitioner's first dependent child was born.
- g. On 1 November 2019, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 22 November 2019 for duty.
- h. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
- i. On 1 May 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B.
- j. On 30 June 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]), while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of November 2020. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 14 November 2020. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 3 May 2021 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of May 2024.
- k. On 12 August 2020, Petitioner's second dependent child was born.
- l. In accordance with reference (c), FY20 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 004/FY20), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 7.0 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N16O/S, rate/NEC was listed.
- m. On 1 September 2020, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 1820), while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of October 2020. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 October 2020. Petitioner's intermediate (02) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 16 November 2020. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 3 May 2021 with a PRD of May 2024.
- n. On 7 December 2020, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: [REDACTED]), while stationed in [REDACTED] with an

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effective date of departure of January 2021. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 19 January 2021. Petitioner's intermediate (02) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 5 February 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 7 July 2021 with a PRD of July 2024.

o. On 7 January 2021, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner's Submarine Pay stopped.

p. On 7 January 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 16 January 2021 for duty.

q. On 7 June 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 7 July 2021 for duty.

r. In December 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC N76Z.

s. On 25 April 2023, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 11 months with an SEAOS of 28 August 2024 in order to match Petitioner's EAOS with PRD.

t. On 18 June 2024, Petitioner's Benefits for Education Administrative Service Tool listed no dependents.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 1 May 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 30 June 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: [REDACTED] with a PRD of May 2024. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c). On 25 April 2023, Petitioner signed an 11-month agreement to extend enlistment to match EAOS to PRD. The Board determined that Petitioner could have reenlisted upon entering Zone B in accordance with reference (b). On 29 August 2020, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB. Furthermore, Petitioner would have been eligible to transfer his education benefits to his dependents if he so chooses.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 11-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 25 April 2023 is null and void.

Petitioner was discharged 28 August 2020 and reenlisted on 29 August 2020 for a term of 4 years.

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Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "7.0" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N16O, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 28 September 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Additionally, Navy Personnel Command is authorized to align transfer of education benefits with the 29 August 2020 reenlistment upon Petitioner's request. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will not take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will not be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). [REDACTED] at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
