Subj: REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORD ICO

1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 30 April 2020 for 5 years, was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of **Constant 1**, **Constant 1**, and **Constant 1** reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 July 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 29 April 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 28 April 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 28 April 2020; "[t]raining in the Nuclear Field program, and advancement to E-4 per MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E-4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled, whether or not I complete nuclear power or advanced training."

b. On 26 August 2016, Petitioner got married.

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c. In October 2016, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N15O.

d. On 11 January 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 10 January 2023 and received a Zone A SRB.

e. On 17 April 2017, Petitioner transferred from a second second

f. On 14 September 2018, Petitioner transferred from **10**, and arrived to on 30 October 2018 for duty.

g. On 11 December 2019, Petitioner's first dependent child was born.

h. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

i. On 29 April 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B.

j. In accordance with reference (c), FY20 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 003/FY20), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15O/S, rate/NEC was listed.

k. On 11 May 2021, Petitioner's second dependent child was born.

1. On 19 August 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2311) with required obligated service to September 2024, while stationed in the service of the stationer of February 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was the stationer of the service of September 2024. Obligated service to September 2024, is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.

m. In October 2021, Petitioner was awarded NEC N15S.

n. On 24 January 2022, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 20 months with an SEAOS of 10 September 2024 in order to incur sufficient obligated service to execute BUPERS order 2311.

o. On 8 February 2022, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner's Submarine Pay stopped.

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p. On 8 February 2022, Petitioner transferred from **Constant and arrived to** on 10 March 2022 for duty.

q. On 18 November 2022, Petitioner's third dependent child was born.

r. On 5 July 2024, Petitioner's Benefits for Education Administrative Service Tool listed no dependents.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 29 April 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 19 August 2021, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 2311 with required obligated service to September 2024. On 24 February 2022, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 20 months to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner could have reenlisted upon entering Zone B in accordance with reference (b). On 30 April 2020, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 5 years and receive a Zone B SRB. Furthermore, Petitioner would have been eligible to transfer his education benefits to his dependents if he so chooses.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 20-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 24 January 2022 is null and void.

Petitioner was discharged 29 April 2020 and reenlisted on 30 April 2020 for a term of 5 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15O, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 10 January 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Additionally, Navy Personnel Command is authorized to align transfer of education benefits with the 30 April 2020 reenlistment upon Petitioner's request. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will<u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). LT**MEN** at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

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4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
