

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 3 September 2021 for 3 years, was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, and _____ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 July 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 4 March 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 3 March 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 3 March 2020; "[t]raining in the Nuclear Field Program and advancement to E4 per MILPERSMAN Articles 1160-040 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN Article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 4 March 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 21 October 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 2950 with required obligated service to September 2024. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c). On 1 January 2021, NSIPS/ESR shows a 16-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 3 September 2021, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 16-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 4 May 2023 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 1 January 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 16 months for OBLISERV to September 2024.

Petitioner was discharged 2 September 2021 and reenlisted on 3 September 2021 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "7.0" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14S, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 3 May 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). LT at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
