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- c. On 16 December 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 15 December 2023 and received a Zone A SRB.
- d. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
- e. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 001/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 7.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N25O/S rate/NEC was listed.
 - f. In November 2020, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N25S.
- g. On 4 November 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order:

), with required obligated service to May 2024 while stationed in

 with an effective date of departure of April 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was

 of 15 May 2021 with a Projected Rotation Date of May 2024. Obligated service to May 2024 is required for this assignment which may be satisfied by reenlistment or extension of enlistment. Circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for SRB eligible sailors.
- h. On 1 January 2021, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS)/Electronic Service Record (ESR) shows a 5-month agreement to extend enlistment with an SEAOS of 15 May 2024.
- i. On 17 April 2021, Petitioner transferred from and reported to on 15 May 2021 for duty.
 - j. On 2 June 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B.
- k. In accordance with reference (d), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 002/FY22), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N25O/S rate/NEC was listed.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 4 November 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: with required obligated service to May 2024. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 1 January 2021, NSIPS/ESR shows a 5-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. On 2 June 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 19 June 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION


That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 5-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 16 December 2023 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 1 January 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 5 months for OBLISERV to May 2024.

Petitioner was discharged 18 June 2022 and reenlisted on 19 June 2022 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N25S rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 15 December 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.



A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
