- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected cancel his 4 year term reenlistment of 8 September 2023 and replace it with a 29 month extension of enlistment to meet the required obligated service (OBLISERV) out to November 2026 as required in BUPERS Order 0873.
- 2. The Board, consisting of reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 5 September 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 29 May 2018, Petitioner entered active duty for 3 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 28 May 2021.
- b. In accordance with reference (b), "...additional eligibility criteria will be published by NAVADMIN. If the current SRB [Selective Reenlistment Bonus] NAVADMIN publishes the use of zones, the guidance regarding zones in table 1-1 must be adhered to. A member may receive only one SRB per zone during a career. When reenlisting for SRB, the reenlistment must take the member's new [EAOS] into the next SRB zone."

- c. On 26 June 2020, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 25 June 2024 and received a Zone A SRB.
- d. On 1 August 2022, Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel notified Petitioner that she was authorized immediate in-rate reenlistment in the Active component with an end date of November 2023.
- e. On 28 March 2023, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: with a required obligated service to November 2026, while stationed in the property of t
- f. On 6 July 2023, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 4-year reenlistment effective 8 September 2023 and SRB. Petitioner's request was approved on 19 July 2023 by cognizant authority.
- g. On 8 September 2023, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 7 September 2027. Additionally, Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613 was signed by Petitioner and witness stating, "08SEPTEMBER2023; Reenlisted this date. Entitled to selective reenlistment bonus (SRB) based on DC 0000 SRB 20110 A. The total SRB entitlement is \$9,230.20. First installment is \$4,615.10. Anniversary Installment is \$1.538.37."
 - h. On 17 October 2023, Petitioner transferred from ______, and arrived to on 7 November 2023 for duty.
 - i. On 29 May 2024, Petitioner entered Zone B.
- j. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was in receipt BUPERS order: 0873, with required obligated service to November 2027. NSIPS shows Petitioner reenlisted lor 4 years on 8 September 2023 and was erroneously approved for a Zone A, DC/0000, 0.5 award level SRB. However, Petitioner had already received a Zone A SRB for his reenlistment on 26 June 2020. Per reference (b), a member may only receive one SRB per zone during a career. The Board determined that a 29-month extension would satisfy the required obligated service in BUPERS order: 0873.

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RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 4-year immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 8 September 2023 is null and void.

Petitioner executed a 29-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) on 13 December 2023. Note: This will reestablish an EAOS of 25 June 2024 and Soft EAOS of 25 November 2026.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
