1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted on 5 June 2024 and was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 September 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 5 June 2014, Petitioner entered active duty and reenlisted on 31 August 2021 for 3 years with an Expiration of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 30 August 2024 and received a Zone B SRB.

b. On 16 November 2021, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System/Electronic Service Record shows a 4-month agreement to extend enlistment with an Soft EAOS of 30 December 2024.

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c. In May 2022, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification C27D.¹

d. On 11 March 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 10 March 2030.

e. On 2 April 2024, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0934) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of June 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 July 2024 with a projected rotation date of August 2028.

f. On 5 June 2024, Petitioner entered Zone C and transferred from [REDACTED] on 14 June 2024 and arrived to [REDACTED] on 8 July 2024 for duty.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosures (2) and (3), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 11 March 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years, however an SRB was not authorized because Petitioner had previously received a Zone B SRB. Reference (d)² was published on 15 April 2024 authorizing Zone C SRB and on 5 June 2024, Petitioner entered Zone C. The Board determined that Petitioner should have been advised to reenlist upon entering Zone C for 6 years and receive a Zone C SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on "4/5 June 2024" vice "10/11 March 2024" for a term of 6 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone "C" SRB with an award level of 3.0 (\$60,000 dollar award ceiling) for the CTM rate. Remaining obligated service to 30 August 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation.

Note: The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will not take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will not be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). The Navy will secure funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
