- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 7 February 2022 for 3 years and was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of \_\_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 April 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 13 November 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 12 November 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 12 November 2020; "Training in the Nuclear Field Program and advancement E4 per MILPERSMAN Articles 1160-040 and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN Article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

- k. On 19 January 2021, Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account shows that Petitioner's Submarine Pay stopped.
- 1. On 19 January 2021, Petitioner transferred from \_\_\_\_\_\_, and arrived to on 19 February 2021 for duty.
- m. In accordance with reference (d), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 9.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the ETN(SS)/N13O/S rate/NEC was listed.
- n. On 11 December 2023, NSIPS/ESR shows a 2-month agreement to extend enlistment with an SEAOS of 4 April 2024.
- o. On 2 April 2024, NSIPS/ESR shows a 10-month agreement to extend enlistment with an SEAOS of 4 February 2025.

## **CONCLUSION**

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 14 May 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 1350 with required obligated service to November 2023. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. Petitioner did not obligate service. On 13 November 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B and was issued official modification to BUPERS order: 1350 with required obligated service to February 2024. On 7 January 2021, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 10 months to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 7 February 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 10-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 7 January 2021 is null and void.

Petitioner's 2-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 5 February 2024 is null and void.

Petitioner's 10-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 5 April 2024 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 7 January 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 10 months for OBLISERV to February 2024.

Petitioner was discharged 6 February 2022 and reenlisted on 7 February 2022 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "9.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the ETN(SS)/N13S, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 4 April 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
