1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's 6-year term reenlistment contract of 29 January 2024 was designated as a Selective Training and Reenlistment (STAR) and he was advanced to E-5 upon reenlistment.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 September 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

- a. On 15 September 2020, Petitioner entered active duty.
- b. In November 2020, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N91T.
- c. On 16 June 2021, Petitioner was advanced to ETN3/E-4.
- d. In August 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC N13O.

e. On 12 August 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 11 September 2022 for duty.

f. In accordance with reference (b), the STAR Program offers career designation to first term enlisted Sailors who reenlist and thereby become eligible for the following career incentives: a. Guaranteed assignment to an appropriate "C" school. b. Possible advancement from petty officer third class (PO3) to petty officer second class (PO2) upon completion of a Class "C" School or a "C" School package, which is listed in NAVEDTRA 10500 and the Career Schools Listing (CSL). Most updated CSL will be located on the MyNavy HR Web page. c. Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB), if eligible (not guaranteed).

g. In accordance with reference (c), rating-NEC ETN-N130/N230 (Submarine Nuclear Propulsion Plant Operator - Reactor Control) with an obligated service of 6 years was listed with the following notes: MPM 1160-100 outlines the obligated service requirements for STAR program reenlistment.

h. On 4 December 2023, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 6-year reenlistment effective 29 January 2024 and Zone A SRB. Petitioner's request was approved 11 January 2024 by cognizant authority.

i. On 29 January 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 28 January 2030.

j. On 29 January 2024, [REDACTED] issued Petitioner an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) listing the following: "Per BUPERSINST 1430.16G, I have been advanced to the rank of Second-Class Petty Officer this date under the STAR Reenlistment Program."

k. On 10 April 2024, Master Military Pay Account shows Petitioner began receiving base pay as E-5 effective 29 January 2024.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an error warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner met the eligibility for reenlistment under the STAR Program and to be advanced upon reenlistment. On 4 December 2023, Petitioner signed NPPSC 1160/1 requesting a 6-year reenlistment and SRB. On 29 January 2024, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years and was issued NAVPERS 1070/613 advancing him to E-5 under the under the STAR Reenlistment Program. However, Petitioner's Command Career Counselor did not properly submit his request as STAR to BUPERS-328 for approval and his contract was not properly designated as a STAR reenlistment.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner executed an immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) on 29 January 2024 for a term of 6 years and listed "Career designated under MILPERSMAN 1160-100."

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
