	On 15 November 2023, U-Haul (Equipment Contract) issued Petitioner an equipment ct receipt for estimated rental charges of \$398.83.
May 2	On 2 February 2024, Petitioner was issued official separation orders (BUPERS order: while stationed in with an effective date of departure of 024. Furthermore, present CO directed to detach member in time to permit completion tion processing not later than 31 May 2024 IAW MILPERSMAN 1050-300 series.

It was certified by a counselor on 5 February 2024.

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d. Petitioner resigned with an honorable character of service and was issued a DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty for the period of 31 March 2017 to 1 May 2024 upon completion of required active service.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an error warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded per reference (b) Household Goods allowances are based on the when orders are effective and certain criteria must be met in order to execute Household Goods transportation before an order is issued. Petitioner was preparing for separation, therefore he had reason to believe that official separation orders would be forthcoming.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's official separation orders (BUPERS order:) were issued on "14 November 2023" vice "2 February 2024."
