- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's reenlistment executed on 8 December 2023 was for a term of 4 years vice 3 years and that he was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of _____, and _____ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 24 October 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 19 October 2017, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an expiration of active obligated service (EAOS) of 18 September 2021 and Soft EAOS of 18 September 2023; "[t]raining in the Advanced Electronics Field (AEF)/advanced Technical Field (ATF) Program and Advancement to paygrade E-4 per MILPERSMAN 1160-040,1160-080, and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution and thereafter may not be canceled except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E-4, 12 months of this agreement may not be canceled, whether or not I complete advanced training."

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b. In June 2019, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N15O.
c. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
d. On 29 July 2020, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 28 July 2026 and received a Zone A.
e. On 9 June 2023, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: with required obligated service to January 2027, while stationed in with an effective date of departure of December 2023. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 11 January 2024 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of January 2027.
f. On 19 October 2023, Petitioner entered Zone B.
g. On 8 December 2023, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years with an EAOS of 7 December 2026.
h. On 11 January 2024, Petitioner transferred from and arrived at on 11 January 2024 for duty.
i. On 22 February 2024, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: with an effective date of departure of April 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 29 April 2024 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of January 2027.
j. On 12 March 2024, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order:) while stationed in with an effective date of departure of May 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 26 May 2024 with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of January 2027.
k. In April 2024, Petitioner was awarded NEC N59X.
1. On 7 May 2024, Petitioner transferred from and arrived to on 24 May 2024 for duty.
m. On 19 October 2027, Petitioner will enter Zone C.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an error warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 19 October 2023 Petitioner entered Zone B. At that time, Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (d). On 8 December 2023, Petitioner reenlisted for 3 years, however and SRB was not authorized because Petitioner's reenlistment did not take his new EAOS into Zone C in accordance with reference (b). The Board determined that Petitioner should have been advised to reenlist for 4 years vice 3 years for SRB eligibility.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 8 December 2023 was for a term of 4 years vice 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 dollar award ceiling) for the MMN/N15O/S rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 28 July 2026 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.



¹ FY24 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 001/FY24), a Zone B SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SS)/N15O/S rate/NEC was listed.

² A member may receive only one SRB per zone during a career. When reenlisting for SRB, the reenlistment must take the member's new EAOS into the next SRB zone.
