- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 22 May 2022 for 4 years, was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of _____, and ____ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 15 October 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 10 March 2015, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 9 March 2019 and Soft EAOS of 9 March 2021; "[t]raining in the Nuclear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500, 1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether or not I complete Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."

On 4 March 2022, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order:) with required obligated service to July 2025, while stationed in with an effective date of departure of March 2022. Petitioner's intermediate (01) activity was for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 4 April 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 23 July 2022 with a PRD of July 2025.
n. On 10 March 2022, Petitioner transferred from arrived to on 5 April 2022 for temporary duty.
o. In April 2022, Petitioner was awarded NEC N14O.
p. In accordance with reference (d), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 002/FY22), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O/S, rate/NEC was listed.
q. On 23 July 2022, Petitioner transferred from and arrived to on 23 July 2022 for duty.
r. In May 2023 Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A. In May 2024, Petitioner was awarded NECs N14O and N59X.
CONCLUSION
Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 17 February 2021, Petitioner was issued orders with required obligated service to December 2024. At that time, a Zone B SRB was

At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 10 March 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 14 February 2022, Petitioner was issued official modification to orders 0481 with required obligated service to June 2025. On 15 February 2022, NSIPS/ESR shows a 7-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the obligated service. On 4 March 2022, Petitioner was issued official modification to orders 0481 with required obligated service to July 2025. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment and would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB on 22 May 2022.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 7-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on

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21 November 2024 is null and void. Note: That any other agreement to extend Petitioner's

21 November 2018 reenlistment is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 4 March 2022 agreeing to extend enlistment for 8 months for obligated service to July 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 21 May 2022 and reenlisted on 22 May 2022 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the EMN(SS)/N14O, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 20 November 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
