- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 27 November 2022 for 3 years, was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, and _____ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 13 August 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 24 November 2015, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 23 November 2019 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 23 November 2021; "[t]raining in the Nuclear Field. MILPERSMAN 1510-030 and MILPERSMAN 1306-500,1306-502, and 1306-504 (NF) are governing directives. Advancement to Rate and Grade per MILPERSMAN 1430-010. I understand that this extension of active service becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN 1160-040 and 1510-030. In particular, I understand that when I accept

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advancement to E4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled whether Nuclear Power or Advanced Training."	or not I complete
b. In February 2018, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (1	NEC) N23O.

1. In accordance with reference (d), FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 001/FY23), a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of 8.5 (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the ETN(SW)/N23O/S, rate/NEC was listed.

m. In May 2023, Petitioner was awarded NEC 805A. In May 2024, Petitioner was awarded NEC N23S.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 28 September 2021, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: with required obligated service to June 2025. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c), however Petitioner was still in Zone A. On 24 November 2021, Petitioner entered Zone B. On 14 December 2021, NSIPS/ESR shows a 9-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner should have signed a NAVPERS 1070/613 vice extension of enlistment. On 27 November 2022, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 3 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 9-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 14 September 2024 is null and void.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 14 December 2021 agreeing to extend enlistment for 9 months for OBLISERV to June 2025.

Petitioner was discharged 26 November 2022 and reenlisted on 27 November 2022 for a term of 3 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "8.5" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the ETN(SW)/N23O, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 13 September 2024 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

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A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
