Dear ██████████,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 24 September 2024. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained in Commander, Navy Personnel Command (NPC) letter 1900 PERS-312/SA of 5 June 2024.

You requested to correct your Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) to show that time at ██████████ is reflected as active duty. The Board in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. In accordance with 10 U.S.C. United States Code, service performed while a member of the program shall not be counted in determining eligibility for retirement or in computing years of service creditable under section 205 of title 37. Therefore, the Board concluded that correcting your DD Form 214 to add your time served while in the program to your net active service is not authorized. However, the years of service at ██████████ as a medical student are creditable in computing retired pay. This was explained in the ██████████ certificate you were issued on 3 July 2019. The Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the aforementioned advisory opinion that your time served at ██████████ should have been listed on your DD Form 214. Accordingly, a Correction to DD Form 214 (DD Form 215) has been issued to annotate the dates you attended ██████████ in Block 18 (remarks). The Board determined that no further change to your record is warranted.
