[REDACTED] (ACC: 342) for duty under instruction. On 26 October 2022, you submitted a NAVPERS 1306/7 requesting SDIP-C for 11 months. The Board determined that for SDIP-C, your request should have been submitted between 6 and 9 months prior to 1 August 2022. Additionally, even if you had requested SDIP-C in the submission window, your request would have been disapproved. You were ordered to [REDACTED] then to [REDACTED], which was a pre-commissioned unit, therefore you were ineligible to receive SDIP for these assignments. In this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the aforementioned advisory opinion.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
