and SBP NIP premium deductions began. Petitioner transferred Permanent Disability Retired List

(SBP) Termination Request to the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for processing. On 5 September 2024, the DFAS denied Petitioner's SBP termination request stating, "[s]ince you have been retired for 75 months, you are no longer eligible to withdraw."

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an error warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner elected SBP NIP coverage for her mother and has been properly assessed monthly premiums since her transfer to the TDRL. However, the Board determined that Petitioner provided evidence to reflect her desire to discontinue SBP NIP coverage on 19 April 2024 and that she meets the criteria to discontinue SBP NIP coverage at any time in accordance with reference (b). Therefore, under these circumstances, partial relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner submitted a request to discontinue SBP NIP coverage on 19 April 2024 and her request was received and processed. Note: The DFAS will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine amounts due, if any.

The part of Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing is denied. Petitioner's record reflects that she elected SBP NIP coverage at the time of retirement and the first evidence of wanting to termination coverage was on 19 April 2024.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.



¹ SBP elections must be made prior to retired pay becoming payable and the election to participate in or decline SBP is irrevocable. An election for a natural person with an insurable interest may be made only when the member is not married and does not have any dependent children upon becoming eligible to participate in SBP. A member must elect full coverage when electing for a natural person with an insurable interest. A member who is participating in SBP with coverage for a natural person with an insurable interest (not a former spouse) may voluntarily terminate their participation in SBP.
