- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to cancel operative/non-operative extension and show that Petitioner reenlisted on 21 October 2020 for 4 years, was eligible for and received a Zone B Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- reviewed Petitioner's allegations 2. The Board, consisting of , and of error and injustice on 9 July 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. On 20 October 2014, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 19 October 2018 and Soft EAOS (SEAOS) of 19 October 2020; "Training in the Nuclear Field program, and advanced to paygrade E-4 per MILPERSMAN articles 1160-040, 1160-080, and 1510-030. I understand that this extension becomes binding upon execution, and thereafter may not be cancelled, except as set forth in MILPERSMAN article 1160-040. In particular, I understand that when I accept advancement to E-4, 12 months of this agreement may not be cancelled, whether or not I complete nuclear power or advanced training."
 - b. In February 2017, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N26O.
 - c. On 28 February 2017, Petitioner transferred from , and arrived to on 29 March 2017 for duty.

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d. On 2 November 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an received a Zone A SRB.	EAOS of 1 November 2023 and

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosures (2) and (3), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 20 October 2020, Petitioner entered Zone B. At that time, a Zone B SRB was authorized in accordance with reference (c). On 25 November 2020, Petitioner was issued BUPERS order: 3300 with required obligated service to September 2024. On 1 February 2021, NSIPS/ESR shows a 10-month agreement to extend enlistment to meet the OBLISERV. The Board determined that Petitioner could have reenlisted upon entering Zone B in

accordance with reference (b). On 21 October 2020, Petitioner would have been eligible to reenlist for 4 years and receive a Zone B SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 10-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 2 November 2023 is null and void.

Petitioner was discharged 20 October 2020 and reenlisted on 21 October 2020 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle Petitioner to a Zone "B" SRB with an award level of "7.0" (\$100,000 award ceiling) for the MMN(SW)/N26O, rating/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 1 November 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, that any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

The Board for Correction of Naval Records (BCNR) will <u>not</u> take any action with the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) for the SRB payment. Petitioner's SRB payment will <u>not</u> be funded by the BCNR's Claims Line of Accounting (LOA). at N133D has secured funding via unexecuted SRB funds and will use their LOA to pay the SRB payment, and will coordinate directly with the DFAS to determine Petitioner's incentive. Contact the Assistant Nuclear Enlisted Program Manager, N133D, concerning SRB payment.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 5.
