The nentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of the ner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.	
under e	fore applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having red all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds ows:	
a. On 24 January 2024, Outbound Interview Summary listed "[t]erminal leave days was modified to 38 days." Additionally, on 29 January 2024, "[Submit for Review] Status changed from Admin Returned to MOL Submitted. Requested detach date is 20240604."		
b. (\$149.8	On 24 February 2024, issued Petitioner a receipt for total rental charges of 7.	
	On 24 February 2024 (08:43), Certified Automated Truck Scale receipt was issued at with gross weight of 8,900 lbs. On 24 February 2024 (12:44), Certified Automated Scale receipt was issued at with gross weight of 11,660 lbs.	



- d. On 3 April 2024, Commanding Officer, United States Marine Corps, Combat Logistics Battalion Combat Logistics notified Petitioner via release from active duty and transfer to the Fleet Marine Corps Reserve that "[o]n 31 July 2024, you will be placed in the Fleet Marine Corps Reserve (FMCR) per the reference (a) [Title 10, U.S. Code]and (b) [MCO 1900.16 (MARCORSEPMAN)]. Accordingly, at 2359, 31 July 2024 you will be detached from your present duty station and released from active duty. You will proceed to your home (MCC W95) and complete all travel within the time specified in the reference (c) [JTR, paragraph 5130, 5230, and 5345-H]. Active duty pay and allowances terminate 31 July 2024."
- e. On 16 May 2024, Petitioner signed an Application for Personally Procured Move (PPM) and Counseling Checklist (DD Form 2278) listing a move from to to to with a maximum authorized weight of 14,000 lbs. and Estimated Government Constructive Cost of \$4,509.00. It was certified by counselor on 21 May 2024.
- f. On 29 July 2024, Travel Voucher Summary (Voucher No. 839224) was paid with a Start Date of 24 February 2024, End Date of 24 February 2024. Advances/Prior Payments: \$0.00, Total Entitlement \$11,517.45, Total Charged to Acct. Class \$11,517.45, Total Amount Payable \$9,650.07, and Due Employee \$9,650.07. Remarks listed the following: "Authorized PPM Weight: 14000 Actual PPM Weight: 5960 Expenses: \$3029.34 GCC: \$11,517.45."
- g. On 29 July 2024, Travel Voucher Summary (Voucher No. 839225) was paid with a Start Date of 24 February 2024, End Date of 24 February 2024. Advances/Prior Payments: \$0.00, Total Entitlement \$4,148.28, Total Charged to Acct. Class \$4,148.28, Total Amount Payable \$3,305.33, and Due Employee \$3,305.33. Remarks listed the following: "Authorized PPM Weight: 14000 Actual PPM Weight: 2760 Expenses: \$316.67 GCC: \$4,148.28."
- h. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded per reference (b) HHG allowances are based on the when orders are effective and certain criteria must be met in order to execute HHG transportation before an order is issued. The Petitioner failed to meet the requirements of reference (b) by execution of HHG shipment prior to issuance of those orders, however Petitioner submitted documentation showing that he was in the process of preparing to retire, therefore Petitioner had reason to believe that official retirement orders would be forthcoming. Additionally, in accordance with enclosure (2), the move was performed with short notice and normal retirements are approved up to 14 months from the retirement date, the Board determined to approve Petitioner's request for reimbursement for his PPM claim.
