1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's effective date of BUPERS Order 0933 (Official Modification to Change Duty Orders) to appropriate date for Personally Procured Move (PPM) of Household Goods (HHG) shipment claim.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

b. On 3 April 2023, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0933) with required obligated service to September 2028, while stationed in the with an effective date of departure of August 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 September 2024 with a projected rotation date (PRD) of September 2028. These orders were modified on 11 April 2024, with transfer funded for member and authorized dependents as reflected on

service record page two and other supporting documents.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded per reference (b) HHG allowances are based on the when orders are effective and certain criteria must be met in order to execute HHG transportation before an order is issued. Orders were issued on 3 April 2023, however there was no line of accounting to allow Petitioner to move HHG. On 11 April 2024 orders were modified which authorized funding for dependents, however Petitioner had already conducted his move based on his original orders. The Board determined that due to administrative error, Petitioner's orders shall be corrected in order for him to settle his PPM.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's modification to orders (BUPERS order: 0933) were issued on 15 March 2024 vice 11 April 2024.

That a copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
