Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 11 October 2024. The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. You contend you underwent a psychiatric medical board, and that training provoked underlying post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) involving childhood sexual trauma and abuse, which was aggravated by service from personnel who harassed you regarding sexual orientation. In reviewing your application, the Board observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board thus determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since the determination of the reason and basis of your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
