This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 23 January 2025. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained in Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps (HQMC) letter 1000 MMPB-21D of 31 July 2024, which was previously provided to you for comment.

You requested correction to your Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) ending 18 September 1999 to reflect item 12f (Foreign Service) for assignment to Marine [REDACTED] from 21 August 1996 to 19 August 1997 and Headquarters and Service Battalion, [REDACTED] from 10 September 1997 to 29 August 1998. [REDACTED] has advised the Board that a DD Form 215, Correction of DD Form 214 will be issued to correct your Foreign Service in [REDACTED] was not considered a Foreign Service area during your assignment period. In this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the advisory opinion and additional changes to your record are not warranted.
