c. On an unknown date, Petitioner's spouse signed DD Form 2656, Data for Payment of Retired Personnel concurring with Petitioner's election to decline SBP coverage. A notary witness signed the form on 26 January 2024.

Personnel and elected not to participate in SBP.

d. Petitioner transferred to the Fleet Reserve effective 1 July 2024, and automatically enrolled in SBP Spouse coverage as a result of spouse's signature not being dated on the DD Form 2656, Data for Payment.

e. On 6 November 2024, Petitioner and spouse signed SBP Affidavit before a notary witness requesting to decline SBP coverage.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an error warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner provided sufficient evidence to reflect his and spouse's desire to decline SBP coverage prior to transferring to the Fleet Reserve. Although the proper administrative requirements were not completed, the Board determined that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner elected to decline participation in SBP with proper spousal concurrence prior to transferring to the Fleet Reserve effective 1 July 2024.

Note: The Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine amounts due, if any.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
