

1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) requesting award of the "Kuwait Liberation Medal" (KLMK) for his service aboard the Enclosures (1) and (2) apply.	
2. The Board, consisting of, and, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 24 January 2025 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of Petitioner's application together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, applicable statutes, regulations, and policies, to include references (b) and (c). Additionally, the Board considered the favorable advisory opinion (AO) furnished by the Navy Department Board of Decorations and Medals (NDBDM).	
	e Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of nd injustice, finds as follows:
	Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. Although Petitioner's

application was not filed in a timely manner, the Board found it in the interest of justice to waive

RECOMMENDATION:

Subj: REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORD OF FORMER MEMBER , USN, XXX-XX-

That Petitioner be issued a Correction to Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 215), for the period ending 7 February 1994, indicating in block 13 that, in addition to the awards already documented in his record, he was also awarded the KLMK.

That no further changes be made to Petitioner's record.

A copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
