1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting her Spouse's record be corrected to change the date of birth listed on his discharge documents.

2. The Board consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 25 October 2024 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of Petitioner's application together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of Subject's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Although the enclosure was not filed in a timely manner, it is in the interest of justice to review the application on its merits.

c. Subject enlisted in the Navy and completed a period of active duty from 17 September 1954 to 6 August 1958.

d. At the time of discharge, he was issued a Armed Forces of the United States Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge (DD Form 214). His DD Form 214 erroneously reflects his date of birth (DOB) as "██████████" vice "██████████."

e. Petitioner provided a copy of her Spouse's birth certificate reflecting his DOB as "██████████".

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board concluded Petitioner's request for correction warrants relief. The Board determined Petitioner provided sufficient evidence to support her contention that an error exists with her spouse's birthday listed on his DD 214.

In view of the above, the Board directs the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Subject be issued a Correction to DD Form 214, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge (DD Form 215) which reflects correction of his DOB to "[REDACTED]".

That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed in Subject's Naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulation, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.]
