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Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 11 October 2024. You contend you were supposed to have received an honorable characterization of service and a different reenlistment code. The Board found you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board thus determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since the determination of the reason and basis of your discharge.

Concerning your request for missing DD Form 214(s), Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty you should contact Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps at 703-784-9204 or email: [smb.manpower.mmrp-10@usmc.mil](mailto:smb.manpower.mmrp-10@usmc.mil) for possible replacement of missing DD Form 214(s) and/or discharge certificates while serving in the Marine Corps Reserve.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
