This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 10 April 2025. The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. In your application, you requested to be reimbursed for money that was taken out of your compensation for separation pay. In reviewing your application, the Board, noting you were discharged on 1 November 1996, observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. Therefore, the Board determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
