This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 12 December 2024. The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. You contend that you were dismissed from Officer Candidate School (OCS) in 2001 for not passing the physical fitness test (PFT). At the time there were members bigger than you. You claim that you were muscular, but you were not given every chance to pass the PFT. Some members were given the opportunity to ride the bike, but you were not. In reviewing your application, the Board observed that you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board thus determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since the occurrence.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
