

Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 12 December 2024. The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. You contend your bad conduct discharge should be changed to a service disability retirement due to mental anguish, physical injuries, and racial injustice that occurred while you were in service. In reviewing your application, the Board observed that you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board thus determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since the determination of the reason and basis of your discharge. Therefore, your request has been denied based on the statute of limitations.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
