
Dear ,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 11 February 2025. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained Navy Pay and Personnel Support Center (NPPSC) memorandum and Navy Personnel Command (NPC) memorandum 2024, which were previously provided to you for comment.

You requested your advancement to Hospital Corpsman Second Class (HM2)/E-5 be corrected on your DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharged from Active Duty. The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. The Board concluded that in accordance with Bureau of Naval Personnel Instruction 1430.16G, personnel who are selected for advancement but are transferred to the Temporary Disability Retired List (TDRL)/Permanent Disability Retired List (PDRL) will be advanced effective the date of transfer to the TDRL/PDRL and advancement should be effected locally via appropriate Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS) entry.

A review of your record reflects that you entered active duty on 23 September 2019 in paygrade E-3 and advanced to HM3/E-4 effective 1 September 2021. In September 2023, you participated in the Cycle 260 Navy Wide Advancement Examination and was selected for advancement to HM2 with an effective date of 16 June 2024. On 15 May 2024, you were frocked to HM2 and transferred to the PDRL effective 31 May 2024.



The Board determined enlisted promotions is not NPPSC's area of responsibility. Therefore, in this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the NPC advisory opinion, and determined a change to your DD Form 214 is not warranted. You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
