Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 20 March 2025. The Board considered that you request promotion to Lieutenant and updated DD 214 so you can bury your wife's remains. You state that you were released from your reserve commitment early because you entered the University of in 1965. When you entered Dental School, you were advised to resign your commission and join the Navy Dental Program. You claim that you communicated with the them, then decided to resign your commission. In reviewing your application, the Board observed that you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board thus determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since your resignation.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
