This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 5 February 2025. After careful and conscientious consideration of the entire record, the Board found that it would not be in the interest of justice to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board noted that you failed to provide the Board with a sufficient explanation for your delay in submitting an application within a reasonable time, and you did not provide evidence to corroborate your assertion of being selected or advanced to Gunner's Mate Second Class/E-5.

The Board did not consider your request for correction to your social security number as your DD Form 214N, Report of Separation from Active Duty was corrected on 1 October 1975. In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
