Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 5 February 2025. You contend that due to your protected communications, the Chief would not have restricted your access to legal counsel and would not have prevented you from calling witnesses who would have provided an alibi for you during the nonjudicial punishment hearing. You claim that your former co-worker signed a statement that she spent the entire weekend in question with you. In reviewing your application, the Board observed that you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. The Board thus determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since your nonjudicial punishment.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
