- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to reflect declined participation in the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP).
- 2. The Board, consisting of \_\_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_\_ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 July 2025 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:
  - a. On 23 July 1997, Petitioner entered active duty.
- b. In October 2001, Petitioner married and and had two children born in September 2005 and July 2008.
- c. On 7 August 2024, Petitioner signed and submitted DD Form 2656, Data for Payment of Retired Personnel and elected not to participate in SBP coverage. Petitioner's signature was not witnessed and the form did not contain spouse's signature.

<sup>1</sup> SBP elections must be made prior to retired pay becoming payable and the election to participate in or decline SBP is irrevocable. If not all requirements for an election needing the spouse's concurrence have been satisfied prior to retirement, for whatever reason, full spouse costs, and coverage will be implemented, regardless of any request by the member to do otherwise. Any change in SBP election subsequent to retirement will be done through an administrative correction of records as permitted by law.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Stipulates service member's signature must be witnessed and the date must match the member's date. The form further indicates spouse SBP concurrence is required when a member is married and elects either: (a) child only SBP coverage, (b) does not elect full spouse SBP coverage; or (d) declines SBP coverage. The spouse signature must be notarized.

- d. Petitioner transferred to the Retired List effective 1 September 2024 and automatically enrolled in SBP Spouse only coverage as a result his signature not being witnessed and not obtaining spouse's concurrence to decline participation before date of retirement.
- e. On 22 November 2024, Petitioner signed another DD Form 2656, Data for Payment of Retired Personnel and elected not to participate in SBP, with proper witness and spousal concurrence.
- f. On 14 February 2025, Petitioner, and his spouse both signed an SBP Affidavit indicating that they desired Petitioner's SBP election to be changed to reflect that he declined SBP coverage. Petitioner indicated that he "received sufficient SBP information/counseling and completed a DD Form 2656, however, it is not on file at the Defense Finance and Accounting Service-Cleveland or was received and is invalid."

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner provided sufficient evidence to reflect his and spouse's desire to decline SBP coverage prior to retirement. Although Petitioner did not complete the proper administrative requirements, the Board determined that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner elected to decline participation in SBP coverage with proper spousal concurrence prior to transferring to the Retired List effective 1 September 2024.

Note: The Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine amounts due, if any.

A copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above titled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
