Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552. Your application was not filed in a timely manner.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 22 January 2026. The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. In your application, you requested your disability rating on the Permanent Disability Retired List (PDRL) changed from 30% to 60%, and to consider 100%; lift a statute of limitations relating Combat Related Special Compensation (CRSC); reissue your DD Form 214 to reflect the period you were pending transfer to the Temporary Disability Retired List (TDRL); and to add a special notation to reflect that you were given additional duties while serving in a particular billet. In reviewing your application, the Board, noting you were notified in 2012 of your transfer to the retired list,¹ observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse the failure to submit your application in a timely manner and was unwilling to waive the three-year statute of limitations due to the length of time since your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
