This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552.

Your application was not filed in a timely manner. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 10 April 2025. In your application, you requested correction to change your rate to Petty Officer Third Class (E-4). In reviewing your application, the Board, noting you were discharged on 22 April 1985, you provided no evidence of passing a Navy Wide Advancement Examination and meeting or exceeding the minimum multiple required to be advanced to E-4. The Board observed you did not provide a sufficient basis to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. Thus, the Board determined your request should be denied due to the length of time since your discharge.

In the absence of sufficient new evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to seek relief, at no cost to the Board, from a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
