On 29 April 2011, you reenlisted in the Active U.S. Naval Reserve for 4 years with a new contract expiration date of 28 April 2015.

On 17 July 2018 you entered Zone C.

On 24 April 2019, you reenlisted for 6 years with a new contract expiration date of 23 April 2025.

In accordance with NAVADMIN 108/20 published on 15 April 2020, this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must have reenlisted within 365 days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270 days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

On 17 July 2022 you entered Zone D.

In July 2022, you were awarded NEC 866A. In July 2023, you were awarded NEC 862A.

On 26 September 2024, you signed a Drilling Reservist Worksheet (Reenlistment/Extension) (NAVRES 1160/1) for a 4 year reenlistment with an effective date of 7 November 2024. Furthermore, your request was approved by cognizant authority.

On 26 September 2024, you signed a Command Career Request (NPPSC 1160/1) for a 5 year reenlistment with an effective date of 7 November 2024. Furthermore, your request was approved by cognizant authority on 30 October 2024.

In accordance with Training and Administration of the Reserve SRB Award Plan published on 1 October 2024, a Zone C SRB with an award level of 1.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) was authorized for the HM/L03A rate/NEC.

On 7 November 2024, you reenlisted for 5 years with a new contract expiration date of 6 November 2029.

On 26 March 2025, SRB/SDAP/STAR Manager notified you that “I am not sure why you were unable to submit the SRB. It doesn't really matter at this point. You are going to have to submit a BCNR to get the SRB. I cannot retroactively approve an SRB for the past...The bad news is that it will take some time for you to get the bonus, but the good news is that there should be no reason you don't get one...”

On 5 August 2025, Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS) / Electronic Service record (ESR) listed your ADSD as 3 May 2025 and your PEBD as 14 June 2004.
