Dear ████████████████████,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 27 January 2026. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinions contained in Commander, Navy Reserve Forces Command (CNRFC) memorandum 5420 Ser N1/428 of ██████████ and Navy Recruiting Command letter 1133 Ser N35 of ██████████, and your response to the opinion.

You requested to establish eligibility to a Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 \$7,500 Prior Service Affiliation Bonus. The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. The Board concluded that you did not meet the eligibility criteria for a Prior Service Affiliation Bonus in accordance with Military Personnel Manual (MILPERMAN) Article 1133-061 and FY 2021 Selected Reserve (SELRES) Enlisted Recruiting and Retention Incentive Program guidance. Specifically, MILPERSMAN 1133-061 indicates the Prior Service Reenlistment Eligibility-Reserve (PRISE-R) Program is a Reserve accession program that allows Navy veterans and other service veterans to affiliate and enlist with the SELRES into available ratings as set forth by Naval Education and Training Command FY recruiting goals, policies, training guidance, and revisions (as applicable). Bureau of Naval Personnel (BUPERS), Reserve Enlisted Community Management Branch (BUPERS-352) administers PRISE-R availability based on community and rating health. Generally, all Service members must obligate in the SELRES (drill pay status) for a minimum of 4 years from date of enlistment or affiliation. However, PRISE-R Sailors may be eligible to receive an enlistment bonus if enlisting for a period of 6 years in an eligible rating published by CNRFC.
